


2019 Annual Report

While public and veteran assistance programs can provide a lifeline for some medical services, for many people, cost is a significant barrier to receiving healthcare.

Foregoing basic care can lead to exacerbated health issues and more costly interventions that can have a significant impact on the individual, their families, and the community as a whole.

Given the significant health risks associated with poor oral care and the costs and consequences of untreated dental needs, Healing California has made improving the oral health status of Californians one of our top priorities.



Improving eyesight is equally as important as maintaining basic dental and health care. Regular eye exams are critical to finding eye diseases early and preserving an individual's vision. Early treatment is critically important to prevent some common eye diseases from causing permanent vision loss or blindness.














